About The School

Summer Percussion Ensemble School is designed to give students the resources to develop their percussion ensemble skills. Many styles of music will be covered, emphasising the development of solid technical fundamentals and exposure to percussion ensemble playing. Students will learn strategies for improving reading skills and proper technique on mallets and other percussion instruments.

Tuition includes:

- All classes and ensemble rehearsals
- Masterclasses and workshops with guest presenters
- Concert performances of the guest artists
- The use of two 5-octave marimbas and other top-of-the-range keyboard percussion instruments
- The use of mallets and auxiliary percussion instruments

Participants will perform in workshop classes and will receive instructions on a variety of percussion subjects, including:
